Sinology Scholarship

The Sinology Scholarship is established to support graduate students in the field of Sinology enrolled in related departments in the European region, including the United Kingdom. The recipient of this scholarship will receive a waiver for one quarter's tuition fee at the International Chinese Language Program (ICLP).

Eligibility:

The applicant must be an enrolled master's or doctoral student at a Sinology-related department in the European region, including the United Kingdom.

Number of Recipients:

1 recipient per academic year

Length of Study:

The recipient may choose one quarter out of the following 3 to use the scholarship while studying with ICLP: 2024 Spring Quarter, 2024 Fall Quarter, or 2024-25 Winter Quarter.

Scholarship Amount:

The scholarship covers the tuition fee for one quarter of study at ICLP out of the following three:

Quarter	Tuition fee
2024 Spring Quarter	NT\$154,500
2024 Fall Quarter	NT\$169,950
2024-25 Winter Quarter	NT\$169,950

Application Requirements:

- 1. Letter of application
- 2. Curriculum vitae
- 3. Research proposal
- 4. Two recommendation letters, one of which written by an instructor in the field of Sinology
- 5. Transcripts

Application Procedure:

- Combine your letter of application, curriculum vitae, research proposal, and collegiate transcripts into one PDF file and send the file to <u>iclp@ntu.edu.tw</u> (subject line: "Application for Sinology Scholarship")
- 2. Ask your referees to send your recommendation letters directly to

The application deadline for the 2024-25 cycle is 24:00 Taiwan time on 15 January 2024.

• Acceptance of Scholarship:

The scholarship recipient must complete registration, including payment of application fee, for one of the above three quarters within the time frame designated by ICLP. Failure to register successfully will result in disqualification. Scholarship results for the 2024-25 cycle is expected to be announced by 31 January 2024.
